- Any requests for alternate times for exams must be made in writing to Mrs Taylor detailing the reason for the request. Requests will only be granted in extenuating circumstances.
- Students are expected to submit all assessment by the due date. If a student has a task that they have not submitted, and the results have not yet been published, they may submit the task before the beginning of the exam period. A valid attempt at a task, although submitted late, may prevent a student Voiding a unit for failing to submit the required 70% of assessment. A reminder that any student Voiding Religious Studies for any reason will be required to complete a minor course in Year 12.
- Exams are compulsory, and any absences must be advised to Mrs Taylor before the commencement of the exam. A date for resits will be arranged as soon as is practicable.
- Students will be issued with a final absence note. Any absences not explained by the end of exam week will be counted in the final decision on Voiding through absences.
