Students will be required to visit the Goodwin House & Village in Ainslie during a morning with their RE class group and will prepare and run activities for the residents. At Merici College, our community seeks to live according to the Christian ideals of St. Angela Merici. By making ourselves available to serve others, particularly those most in need, we can participate in creating a more just and compassionate society. During their Service Project, the girls will have a unique opportunity to live out these ideals.

The Merici College Christian Service Learning Program in Year 9 encourages the students to reach out to and come to respect and appreciate the experience and gifts that elderly people in the community have to offer. Each student is required to complete 4 hours of service during school time (which includes preparation class time prior to the visit) but are encouraged to accumulate their service hours assisting with an elderly person in their neighbourhood, or an aged care facility. This is also an opportunity for the girls to develop their confidence and skills as a servant leader; displaying empathy and a broader understanding of our elderly community.

Please be aware that the topic of death and dying might be raised by residents at the aged care facility, please communicate with your daughter's RE Teacher if your daughter may find this topic difficult to talk about. Your daughter's RE teacher and the Head of Mission and Community are coordinating the visits.
