



334 Squadron Australian Air Force Cadets is now recruiting new members in Canberra

The Australian Air Force Cadets (AAFC) is a youth development organisation, sponsored by the Royal Australian Air Force, dedicated to providing opportunities for young Australians to obtain comprehensive personal challenges and growth, leadership, self-reliance, confidence and teamwork.

Some activities undertaken by the AAFC include aviation, leadership, safe weapons handling, fieldcraft, first aid, drill and ceremonial, communications, flying, fieldcraft, adventure training, service knowledge, aeromodelling, navigation and gliding.

Candidates must be not less than 13 years old upon enrolment. Cadets can then continue until they reach the age of 18 years. Candidates must be Australian citizens or have permanent resident status.

All people above 16 years of age attending this session will need to bring either proof of identity (e.g. drivers licence) or, if held, an ADF or Defence ID card, in order to be able to enter the base. Please park vehicles in the area in front of the main gate.
