### Registration Costs

The costs for registration will be as follows  
Merici College Registration Fees - All players \$200

This covers team registration fees, Volleyball ACT membership, first aid kits, volleyballs and end of year trophies.

Uniform fees – for those requiring uniform please indicate this on the Merici College Volleyball Online Registration Form. Uniforms take approximately 6 weeks to arrive from ordering. Please get your daughter to be fitted as soon as possible at the uniform shop. Your daughter is able to wear her PE shirt until these arrive. The order cannot be put in until everyone is fitted. This needs to be done before end of term 1.

Shirt - \$55  
Shorts - \$35  
Socks - \$10

Completion of the Merici College Volleyball Online Registration Form, registration fees and uniform payment are required by **Friday 30 June, 2023**.

### Coaches, Managers and Referees

The biggest hurdle faced each year is finding coaches for the teams. I would appreciate any parent, whether you understand volleyball or not, who is able to volunteer to coach, manage or referee to contact me as soon as possible.

All teams are required to have a parent as a Manager to register – no team will be allowed to play for Merici College without this. This is not a big commitment so please consider this role for your daughter's team.

### Volleyball Season

The competition is organised by Volleyball ACT and is played at Lyneham Hockey Centre and Harrison High School on Tuesday nights Games last season were played on the half hour from 4.30pm until 10.30pm (games for younger teams are usually completed by 7.30). The Autumn season commences Tuesday 18 July. Please note that we believe games will not be held during the school holidays.

### Training

I ask that before completing forms and committing your daughter to volleyball that you are aware of what this commitment entails. Teams will train on Monday or Wednesdays afternoons (not both) or possibly a morning. It is an important part of developing teamwork, commitment and awareness of responsibility and parents need to reinforce this. **Your daughter will be marked off each week as to whether she attends or does not attend. If she misses three (3) trainings, parents will be contacted.** As well as playing on Tuesday evenings, all teams except division C juniors will have duty – this is done roughly 7 times a season.

In order for teams to be registered, each team will require a minimum of eight players, a coach and manager.
