MERICI COLLEGE SNOW SPORT COORDINATORS

1. Supervision, Accommodation and Permission:

The excursion will be attended by Mr Adrian Heim and with Ms Diana Davis as the Merici Snow-Sports Coordinators. We are both experienced and avid skiers - so come sun, sleet or snow, we are on the slopes with the girls all the time. We are also both 'Provide First Aid' qualified.

As well we are anticipating the presence of several parents and strongly encourage them to register on-line as a Team Manager and/or a Race Course Volunteer - and generally be on the snow with the girls.

The involvement of Mums and Dads simply makes the excursion safer for all, and is the difference between a good time and a great time!

Group accommodation is at the Station Resort in Jindabyne.

Rooms are blocked adjacent to each other and each room accommodates up to 6. It is a relaxed, fun atmosphere where girls can meet students from other schools with lots of team interaction and making friends - particularly at meal times. We have 4 rooms booked accommodating up to 24 at this stage - it is 'first in best dressed'.

Girls can of course stay with their parents in their own lodgings, however we very much encourage them to stay with the Team at the Station for a valuable team bonding experience.

As this is an overnight excursion requiring approval by Catholic Education, included with this letter is an additional consent form titled "Snow Sports 2018 – CE Permission note – cat C & D Excursions".

This form must be completed in full and returned along with this signed permission slip.

Permission notes including medical details along with <u>payment in ful</u>l must be returned to the Finance Office no later than Thursday 31st May, 2018.

Note: This excursion will only proceed subject to approval by Catholic Education.

2. Races and Events:

These include giant slalom, skier X, moguls and even Nordic skiing (cross country) that cater well to nearly all standards of skiers and boarders from early intermediates to expert and advanced.

Most events require a team of 4 and the top 3 results count towards team results.

Also, there are *individual results* and placings for each event.

So that team lists can be prepared before they are submitted to ACT Interschools, please indicate on the slip provided the events that your daughter will be competing in and return with this permission slip. Each event costs \$47.

3. Team Managers:

Each event requires a Team Manager either myself or Ms Davis, or an attending parent who is responsible for handing out race bibs to the girls and assembling them at the right time and place for each race. If you don't already have a lift ticket, Team Managers are entitled to a discounted lift ticket (previously an Adult ticket at Child rate) on the day of their nominated event.

4. Waiverforms:

In addition to information about skiing events – waiver forms releasing liability in the event of accidental death or injury must be downloaded, signed and submitted by parents in order that their daughter be allowed to participate. http://actinterschools.com.au/participant-waiver

Please complete waiver forms online as well as advise which event your daughter will compete in at the same time you submit this permission slip (due date 31st May) so that we can firm up our team entries early and with certainty.

5. Parentvolunteers:

As a College Team we are required to provide at least one volunteer for every 8 participants to marshall on course. Marshalling is easy and fun and is closest to the action you can get – again volunteers receive a free lift pass on the day of their allocated event. http://nswinterschools.com.au/volunteer-waiver.

6. Lift PassandSki-Tube:

As we are *on the go* and movement on and off the mountain is pacey, and to avoid having to purchase lift tickets separately in the morning, we require the girls have their lift and ski-tube passes sorted well before the excursion either by:-

- purchasing as part of this excursion permission or,
- having their own season pass a photocopy of which must be submitted to either coordinator by Friday 13th of July, 2018

7. Equipment:

Your daughter must be adequately equipped with suitable snow-gear for the competition prior to departure including:

- goggles and a helmet (compulsory)
- properly adjusted skis and stocks or snowboard as appropriate
- layers of warmth
- sufficient fluids, money for incidentals, sun screen, etc
- properly fitting boots

Note there will be little or no opportunity to purchase equipment or gear whilst on the excursion.

8. ACT Interschool's Website:

For more information on races and events, being a team manager, waiver forms and volunteering as a race marshall, as well as lift passes and expectations on equipment please refer to the ACT Inter-Schools snow sports website: http://www.actinterschools.com.au/

9. Excursion Cost:

Cost for the excursion varies depending on whether your daughter requires :-

- transport using the college bus \$25
- team share accommodation \$132 and meals \$105 for the full 3 days
- lift and ski-tube passes at child rate is \$250*

*discounted prices are sourced from the Perisher website and are based on a *pre-payment* of both lift and tube pass for the group at least 28 days prior. It costs about 12% more to purchase these on the snow.

Note:

- Parents purchasing season passes for their daughter must do so directly with Perisher Blue.
- Some students may have their own season pass and/or their own lodgings with parents and/or their own transport with parents. Private arrangements for any or all of these may be in place and therefore *these costs are optional* and must be ticked when completing the cost section of excursion summary.

The following costs are not optional:-

- the number of events entered \$47 per event
- skier registration is \$30
- staff supplementation \$90

Lastly the supplementation charge of \$90 is added to cover the cost of 2x staff members attending for accommodation, meals and/or lift passes as well as incidentals for the girls whilst away e.g. hot chocolates at the Distillery Café at Crackenback.
