Rationale/Purpose

Merici College has a compulsory school uniform. This uniform is our identity and when students wear the uniform outside of school they represent the school and all it stands for.

Merici College is committed to ensuring all our students wear the College uniform appropriately. The uniform does follow WHS regulations regarding safe footwear and the wearing of excessive jewellery.

Procedures

Full Merici Uniform is compulsory.

All garments should be clearly marked with the student's name. All uniform items MUST be maintained in presentable, wearable fashion at all times- broken shoes, jumpers with holes in them and torn uniforms are not acceptable at any time. Students will be asked to remove these items and replace them.

 Ribbons, scarves, beanies and gloves to be in school colours (navy gold, maroon, black, white). Scarves, beanies and gloves to be worn ONLY to and from school due to very cold mornings and late afternoons - NOT to be worn during the school day.

Uniform requirements for Years 7-10

Summer Winter

- Summer Dress knee length or below knee
- College navy wool jumper
- Plain white fold-over ankle socks or higher
- College school bag or satchel (compulsory)
- Sturdy lace-up plain black polishable leather school shoes which cover the whole foot (no Mary-Jane style shoes, no ballet slippers, no heels greater than 4cm and no backless shoes, no buckles).
- Merici College school bag or satchel (compulsory)
- Ribbons and scarves to be in school colours (navy gold, maroon, black, white)

Sport

- College sports shirt (new blue shirt compulsory for all Year 7 to Year 10 students and Senior PE)
- College PE shorts with school logo
- Plain white fold-over ankle socks or higher
- PE Rugby top (optional)
- Suitable sports shoes
- College tracksuit (compulsory for all Year 7 to Year 10 students and Senior PE)
- College cap or wide brimmed hat
- Ribbons, scarves, beanies and gloves to be in school colours (navy gold, maroon, black, white)

- Winter wool skirt- knee length or below knee
- College white blouse
- Sheer or opaque black tights
- College navy wool jumper
- Regulation navy trousers
- College jacket (optional, pictured below)
- Sturdy lace-up plain black polishable leather school shoes which cover the whole foot (no Mary-Jane style shoes, no ballet slippers, no heels greater than 4cm and no backless shoes, no buckles).
- Merici College school bag or satchel (compulsory)
- Ribbons, scarves, beanies and gloves to be in school colours (navy gold, maroon, black, white). Scarves, beanies and gloves to be worn ONLY to and from school due to very cold mornings and late afternoons - NOT to be worn during the school day.

SPORT UNIFORM ITEMS CAN NOT BE MIXED IN WITH THE REGULAR SCHOOL UNIFORM

HAIR is to be tidy at all times. Extreme styles or colour changes are not acceptable.

MAKE-UP is to be discreet and nail polish is to be of a neutral shade. While at school, the only alternative clothing, which should be worn, is the sports uniform for PE and Dance and correct attire for Hospitality.

JEWELLERY: Students may wear a simple ring, a bracelet, a silver or gold chain necklace, and a maximum of two pairs of small sleeper/studs in the lobe of the ear only.

NO OTHER ITEMS OR PIERCINGS ARE PERMITTED and students will be asked to remove these.
