COVID-19 Update for the Principal

We find ourselves in changing times right now. As promised, we will be keeping you up to date and informed. This morning I received notification from Catholic Education that all schools comply with the following directions as a precautionary approach to minimise the risk of further spread of COVID-19:

- Postpone or cancel all school events that involve large gatherings such as assemblies, fetes, parent/teacher nights, open days/nights, sport carnivals, community assemblies and liturgies.

YEARS 7, 8 AND 9 NEWS

NAPLAN Practice

NAPLAN assesses literacy and numeracy – important skills that each child needs to succeed in school and life. The NAPLAN tests are designed to help us make sure students are on track with their literacy and numeracy development. Students in Years 3, 5, 7 and 9 participate in NAPLAN tests for reading, writing, conventions of language (spelling, grammar and punctuation) and numeracy.

Between Tuesday 24 and Friday 27 March our school will participate in NAPLAN Practice, which are designed to give students, teachers and systems an opportunity to practice administering and participating in the online testing environment. The practice consist of a Writing Test for Years 5, 7, & 9, and an Omnibus Test (a combination of reading, conventions of language and numeracy) for Years 3, 5, 7 & 9. As this is intended to practice participation, the questions are not equivalent to NAPLAN testing in May, and no results are available from the Practice. Christian Service Learning Program - Update

Due to Australian Government advice regarding Covid-19, the College has been advised that some volunteering opportunities in the broader community have been cancelled (eg. Menslink Big Night Out, Caritas Kitchen). Students who currently volunteer in the broader community (eg. Vinnies Stores) are instructed to follow Australian Government advice and regulations regarding the participation in such volunteering. These events are not supervised or organised by Merici College. Any school-based service opportunities will also adhere to directives as set out by the Catholic Education Office. Parents, carers, students and staff will be advised of any future service opportunities. At this stage, the Year 7 Lenten Program is continuing (see below for updated specific advice) however, future planning for Year 9 visits to Goodwin House, Ainslie is postponed until further notice.

Year 7 Lenten Program

Year 7 students are currently participating in their Christian Service Program called the Lenten Project during the period of Lent. Students have been instructed to commit to volunteering for 10 hours serving people in need and learn from the experience about the gift of caring for others. iC NEWS

Merici College has a number of databases and resources that are available from home 24/7. These are all located on our <u>Moodle system/site home</u>. One such database, Sora by Overdrive is a digital library of eBooks and audio-books for students of all year levels, as well as adults. The collection includes fiction, as well as non-fiction titles related to the Australian curriculum topics. The current collection includes over 10,000 eBooks and audiobooks, including 'Read-a-long' books.

The collection is available 24/7 from any device. It can be accessed through <u>Merici Moodle</u> or by downloading the Sora app onto your IOS or Android device. Books can also be read off line on a laptop accessing Sora through <u>soraapp.com</u>.

- 2. Search for a school: ACEN Member Collection
- 3. Choose our school from the drop-down menu: Merici College
- 4. It will redirect you back to the Merici Login
- 5. You can then borrow three items at any one time
