


Claim the Date: Academic Awards Semester 1 2019 (Monday 19 August)

Cross-Age Tutoring (All Languages)

The Languages Department has had a successful trial run with Cross Age Tutoring for Mandarin Chinese in Term 2. We are now extending this program to all languages. The aim of this program is to provide extra assistance for students who are finding learning French, Italian or Mandarin difficult and hoping to strengthen students' foundation in the language that they are learning.

As a tutor, students get to coach/teach their peers who need assistance in the subject. It is also a great opportunity for a tutor to consolidate their learning outside of class. To apply to be a tutor, we require the tutor to have solid knowledge on the language and also a strong sense of commitment and responsibility. Service Hours will be awarded to tutors. Students who either want to become tutors or would like to be tutored need to get in contact with their language teachers. The respective language teachers will pass on the list to Mrs Jen Baines. Mrs Baines will inform both tutors and tutees of when tutoring sessions will begin. The sessions will likely begin in Week 3 either on Wednesday or Thursday during lunch time. Participants in the program are allowed to eat their lunch during the sessions.


Vinnies Dickson - Volunteering
