Dear Parent/Guardians,

As Year 12 come to the end of their journey at Merici College, they are required to attend their annual Year 12 Retreat. It is an overnight Retreat from Wednesday afternoon (after school) 25 July to Friday 27 July 2018. Students will have normal lessons on Wednesday 25 July before leaving for the Retreat straight after school.

The Year 12 Retreat is called "Dare to Dream". It is a compulsory "camp style" session off campus. It will be facilitated by Amy Connellan (Head of Mission and Community). The venue is conducive to reflection, meditation, spiritual journaling and drawing. The Retreat has a very strong spiritual focus to allow students to reflect deeply as their journey at Merici comes to an end. Students are encouraged to discuss their own hopes and dreams for Yr 12 and for the years ahead and to reflect on the potential for the transformation that exists in the obstacles and difficulties they will encounter in their future. Students will be led to a deeper awareness of the values and beliefs necessary to achieve their dreams through an exploration of the questions – who am I, where have I come from and where am I called to? Students will also participate in a Yoga session, active team-building games, walking and an evening campfire.

The Retreat will be held at the Warrambui Retreat and Conference Centre in Murrumbateman; a perfect venue for reflection. The students will travel by coach; leaving Merici College at 3.45pm on Wednesday afternoon, returning to Merici College at 3.15pm on Friday afternoon.



Dress for the Retreat days will be neat casual. All food for the overnight component conference is provided. Students are requested to bring the following:

- Appropriate shoes for walking
- Warm Clothes
- Sleeping Bag or Bed Linen, Pillow Case and Towel
- A chocolate bar of their choice which best describes themselves (for a specified activity)

The cost of the Retreat is \$242.00 per student (cost is included in fees). This includes all meals, guest speakers, accommodation and coach travel to and from the venue.
