


We offer you the choice of many electives, but we will NOT be running them all. What we run will depend on what you choose.

Who is it for? Everyone!



Students will work to prepare and deliver an enrichment project. This could be a set of posters, running a primary school Mathematics Competition or anything you can think of.


At the same time working to develop skills across all Mathematical areas.

*Note, these are not electives but a HASS choice. You cannot study Civics or Economics in Year 10 if you studied them in Year 9.


