
Push bike hire to tour the gardens of the castle.

Accommodation will be either in a youth hostel or a 2-star hotel
















First of four French language classes conducted by a language school.

Day Twelve








Second of four French language classes. (9–12pm).

Evening No. 4 in hostel.










Day Fourteen

Afternoon: Free time in Toulouse as a group to sightsee & go shopping.



Day FIFTEEN









Afternoon: Nîmes. This town is known as the Ancient Rome of France!






Day Sixteen



Morning: Coach to Colias where we will meet a professional guide to have a 2-hour canoe trip ending at the magnificent Pont du Gard.


Afternoon: Free afternoon in Nîmes to relax & sightsee as a group.









Day Seventeen

Arrive in Nice in late afternoon. A classy city with distinct Italian character & vibrant Mediterranean energy!










Afternoon: flight home from Nice International Airport.











